Placement Criteria:

Priority Order of Placement

- Students for whom Bentleigh Secondary College is the designated neighbourhood school.
- 2. Students who reside permanently at the same address and has a brother or sister currently attending the Bentleigh Secondary College.
- 3. Students seeking enrolment on specific curriculum grounds*.
- 4. In a limited number of cases, a student may be enrolled on compassionate grounds, where there are significant family or individual circumstances. Wherever possible, the College will attempt to enrol students from main feeder primary schools who reside outside of zone provided that there are spaces available.
- 5. Any additional spaces available will filled with students who are the next closest to our school zone.

*Specific Curriculum Grounds Claims

Parents/guardians who live outside the neighbourhood area may be considered for enrolment on the following curriculum grounds:

- 1. The student has been studying either French or Japanese at primary school, their child's neighbourhood school does not offer these languages as part of the curriculum and the child is interested in pursuing these studies to a senior level.
- 2. The student has a desire to participate in Gifted and Talented Program (GaT) or Sport Academy.
- The student has a desire to participate in the Instrumental Music Program and has a proven interest in that area of the curriculum.
- 4. The parent/guardian is able to demonstrate clear curriculum continuity links between their child's primary school and the college.
- The parent/guardian is able to demonstrate that the college provides a specific curriculum focus that is not available at other secondary colleges.

Additional information may be sought to support an application for enrolment on curriculum grounds. It is essential that all communication between the college and parents is in writing and processed according to the above guidelines.

To assist with your application (under curriculum grounds) please provide any evidence to support your application such as: semester reports, music awards, sporting achievements or any other relevant material.
